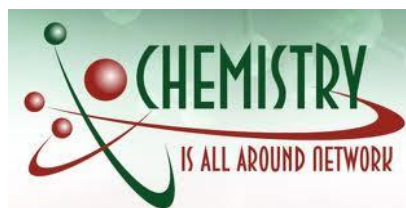
NEW PERSPECTIVES FOR CHEMISTRY TEACHING
