



Strategies for introducing and developing difficult topics in Leaving Certificate Chemistry

This course will cover strategies for teaching difficult topics in chemistry. The workshop will look at how Electrochemistry may be presented as a complete package using inexpensive equipment and exciting resources.

Reaction mechanisms in organic chemistry can be a difficult concept for students to understand. This workshop will explore innovative ways of explaining mechanisms through hands-on activities.

Teachers will explore strategies, activities, worksheets, animations, videos and resources that will aid them in the presentation of these concepts and in the engagement of students.
