

# ISTA / IOP DRAMA Photographic Competition

(DRAMA: Drop Reaction And Microfluidic Analysis)

## Who can enter?

- The competition is open to all secondary school students in the Republic of Ireland.
- The candidate must have taken the photographs entered - copies of another photographer's work are not permitted.
- The competition is not open to immediate family members of ISTA, DCC, IOPI members or those involved in the organisation of the DRAMA event.

## What must I do?

- All competition entries must be mounted (see Youtube.com "Mounting Prints" instructional video)
- Entries must be received by the 30th of April 2012. The candidate must retain the original photograph (digital file or negative). Photographs received electronically will not be accepted.



- Each entry must be accompanied by the candidate's contact details (to include first name, last name, school name and address, candidates email address, contact telephone number). The location of where the photograph was taken must also be provided). This information must be typed and pasted to the back of the mounting board.

## What can I win?

- The overall winning candidate will receive a **trip to Florida** with flights, accommodation and entry in to the **JFK space centre** for them and an accompanying adult.
- There are runner up prizes for both the best junior entry (1st to 3rd Yr) and the senior (4th to 6th Yr) entry of a Cannon Eos SLR camera.
- The photograph voted as the overall winner of the competition and the 11 runner up photographs may be reproduced as a calendar. No fee shall be payable to either the winning candidates or those placed in 4th to 12th place for production or distribution of the photographs
- Winning and runner up photographs and photographers may be featured in some media coverage at the time of the event in September.
