

Engineering and Science/Construction Law-Finance Career lecture



The lecture is centred around two key social/technological trends: *'The Urban Century'* and the *'Fourth Industrial Revolution'* which will occur over the next 30-40 years.

Over the next 20 years investment of at least €70 Trillion will be required for urban area

developments, energy systems and transport networks in order to sustain economic growth as 2 billion people move from rural to urban areas. Alongside this the new areas of advanced production and computerisation, sustainable energy systems, nanotechnology and biotechnology will usher in the 'Fourth Industrial Revolution' around the world which will create business and economic opportunities.

Paul MacDonald travels to regions such as Europe, America and Asia in order to research these trends in the demand for engineering products and infrastructure.
