All published entries are visible. An international jury will judge the entries.

The winning stamps will be on show during the IYC 2011 Closing Ceremony in the Grand

Palais in Brussels, Belgium. We might be able to facilitate the designers of the winning

stamps to attend this ceremony on December 1, 2011 to attend a student's programme.
