Join [Mike Hulme](#), Professor of Climate and Culture in the Department of Geography at King's College London as he discusses how a variety of insights about climate and its cultural and political manifestations can offer a sufficient number of entry points for human actors to work creatively with the idea of climate change.



In his 2009 book, *Why We Disagree about Climate Change*, Professor Hulme considered the different ways people think about climate change in the contexts of science, economics, religion, psychology, risk communication, development sociology, and politics. In the six years since that book was published, new developments have occurred in nature, science, politics and culture, yet climate change continues to be an idea which both unites and divides opinion.
