- The website can be easily developed to include a blog, homework assignments, news for parents, RSS feeds etc.

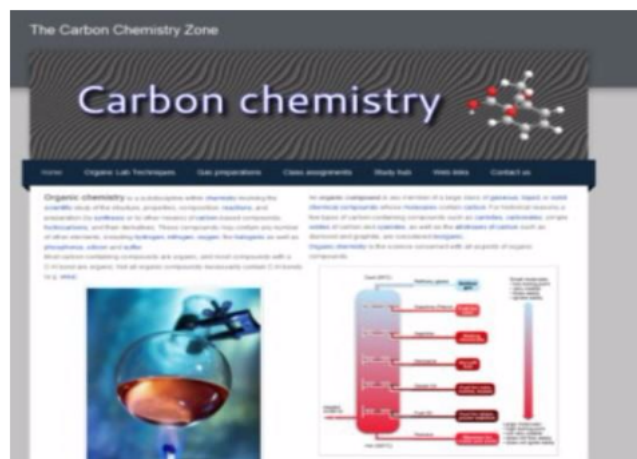
Yes it's true, by the end of the night you will have your own live online chemistry website.
