The 2011 awards

This year the awards are open to the entire science teaching community. From mid October to the end of February, 2011, ISTA members currently teaching science at post-primary level may apply. Entrants will be required to give a presentation to their local branch between now an the end of February. An electronic copy of this presentation along with evaluation forms, attendance roll and a completed application form should be forwarded to Siobhan Murphy. The top four entries will be required to give their presentation at the ISTA Conference in April 2011, at which an overall winner will be selected. Application forms and guidelines can be downloaded from the ISTA and PharmaChemical Ireland websites.

The winners will be announced at the Irish Science Teachers' Association annual conference in Thurles in April 2011. The runner up will receive two years membership of the ISTA, an LCD projector and a cash prize of €500.

The overall winner will receive a prize of ten years membership of the ISTA, a laptop computer and a cash prize of €1,000.
