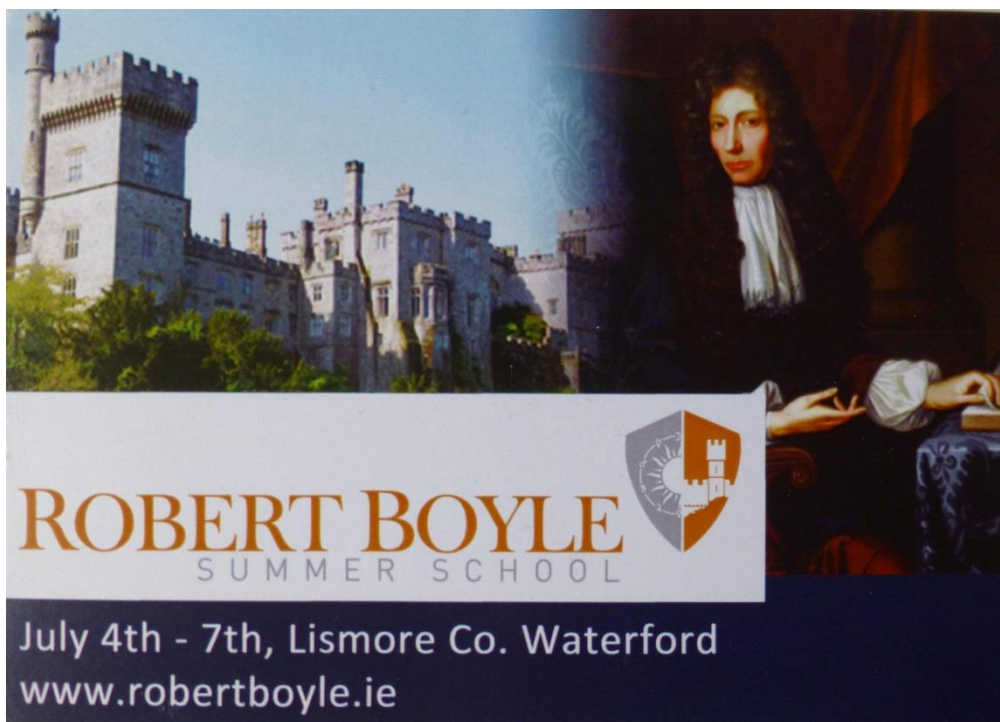


Robert Boyle
